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NEHA DANI DEBUTS NEW AND RECENT WORK AT THE PALM BEACH SHOW

Internationally acclaimed jewelry artist showcases a new moonstone necklace reflecting her sculptural and intricate practice alongside recent creations

PALM BEACH, FL, January 20, 2023—[Neha Dani](#), internationally acclaimed jewelry artist, is pleased to participate for a second year in a row at the 20th annual [The Palm Beach Show](#) from **February 16-21, 2023**. Held at the Palm Beach Convention Center, this will mark the debut of a stunning new neckpiece made from moonstones and diamonds as part of her [Glacier series](#).

“I’m delighted to return to The Palm Beach Show. I have a deep appreciation for the vibrancy of the Palm Beach community and look forward to debuting my new work. I continue to be inspired by the natural world and strive to create something new, mesmerizing, and always with joy inside,” said Neha Dani.

The artist will also be showing three new pieces marking their U.S. debut. Extending the Glacier series further, the *Alek Ring* is artistically constructed of dramatic cuts of moonstone that reflect the blue sheen of glacial ice and are mounted on custom blue titanium, and the *Agalina Earring Tops* each have a trio of iridescent moonstones bordered by a wreath of step cut and round diamonds. A standalone pair of earrings, titled *Akiko Earrings*, move with the wearer and almost dance as the oscillating bands of anodized titanium set with rose-cut and brilliant-cut diamonds twist in their helix forms. Each gem exudes energy and luminosity of the free spirited soul.

Additional series of works including *Architectural*, *Blossoming Flowers*, *Cadence*, *Feuille*, *Kephi*, *La Pluma*, *Shrishti*, and *Tidal* will be on view embodying Dani’s love of nature. Each piece is a wearable work of art.

Dani learned the art of wax carving at the Gemological Institute of America. Going against the computer-aided software that is widely used in jewelry design, she has followed the handicraft traditions of her Indian heritage and found joy in experimenting with carver’s tools to create intricate works.

Her tireless process leads to bespoke jewelry that add to her legacy as a designer and passion for creativity. Craftsmanship is vital, and her work encompasses her personal cultural inspirations through a modern lens.

ABOUT NEHA DANI

Neha Dani's oeuvre, with its attention to detail and innovation of form, has made her one of the most compelling voices in the world of jewelry. Dani works much as a sculptor would, starting with a three-dimensional and individually carved wax model that she then refines to perfection. Notably, Dani pays as much attention to the stones she sources as she does to her designs, scouring the world for the perfect gemstones, which she hand-selects for her creations. The stones are then set by master craftsmen using a combination of old-world techniques and modern technology to produce unique pieces of jewelry art.

These multilayered sculptures speak of a deep intrinsic philosophy, inspired by the natural world and the human emotions that reside within each piece. Dani's designs tell a story from every angle, striking a delicate balance between feminine aesthetic and bold, dramatic scale. They exhibit an intricacy with forms, curves, and colors that are as exceptional as the women who wear these works of art.
